These projects may be private, public, NGO or community driven projects. These projects also should have had a community-engaged, participatory design/planning component in addition to measurable indicators of their impact. Also included in this category are pro-bono projects with a social impact. (And, projects entered in this category may be entered in other categories in the awards program.)*

Lower-resolution images should be used within the project entry. (We are asking for a separate hi-res image for use in publicity. The media image needs to be 5-10 MB JPG, at 300 dpi resolution for print. And the image should be one that crops well as a horizontal or a vertical view of the project.)

The final project entry submission file should not be more than 10 MB total.
